

UP & DOWN

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Fill the empty squares with digits (either 1 to 5, 1 to 6, or 1 to 7, as indicated above the grid) so that no row or column contains the same digit twice, and so each thickly bordered grid piece has its numbers in numerical order (either increasing or decreasing, though not necessarily consecutively).

Not every digit will appear in every row and column. The example at right uses digits 1 to 5.
